Parkgate



The lane providing access to the rear of the house is likely to be closed to vehicles for repairs on the party weekend. Best to park elsewhere and bring stuff in by hand or drop off and move on.

Parkgate gets very busy on weekends, especially Bank holidays with good weather so parking can be tricky. There are the following options.



A: Free, unrestricted, anywhere without yellow lines along The Parade next to the Marsh or other side of road. Spaces can be rare during the day at weekends but you might get lucky. After about 19:00 and in bad weather there is more space.

Watch out for the yellow lines. They are enforced.





B. Parkgate School Lane car park Free, unrestricted parking close to Seaview, behind the toilets, but it is not very big and you will be lucky to find a space.



C. Free, unrestricted on the residential roads behind the old church. You might find a space, but be mindful of the residents.





D. Parkgate Ropewalk Car Park

Height barrier. Free unrestricted parking, but in theory the entry barrier is closed at night. At present it remains open though.

Not too far to walk if you go along the Ropewalk rather than The Parade.

E. Parkgate North Wirral Way Parking

As above but more of a walk to Seaview. Also has a height barrier.


F. Football field parking





Free, unrestricted and secluded parking. No parking bays. Can be busy weekend mornings with football family parking.

G. The Old Quay parking



Commercial parking and often full during the day. Free if you eat in the pub.


Campervan overnight parking in Parkgate

You do see campervans parked on the Parade, location A. Prime spot is right at the South end where there is less traffic and less camber on the road but often occupied. North of Seaview outside Mr Chows there is less camber and it is less busy.

I don't see any reason not to park up at location F by the football field but may get busy on Sunday morning.

Car Park at location B off Mostyn Square is good if you can find a space and don't have a huge van.

Neston



Access to the Town Hall is from the glass enclosed staircase at the rear. There is a wheelchair lift. You can drive into the marketplace by turning left in front of the Sainsbury's multi storey off Brook St. "Never mind the bollards" they are never up. You can park right next to the lift access door to unload (but don't obstruct the police cars) the top floor of Sainbury's multistorey is on the same level and very close but you need to drive into the multi story to reach it. It has some disabled parking places.



Neston Parking

A Neston Chester Road parking



Free and unrestricted but people have been fined for parking outside bays. Not really an issue now the bays are clearly marked. Generally space available in the evening. Very close to venue.

B Sainsbury's multistorey



Restricted to 3 hours and occasionally checked during the day. Sainsbury's closes at 10PM but I don't think the car park gates are shut then. Direct access to the back of the Town Hall.

C Aldi and station parking



Restricted to 1 1/2 hours and strictly camera enforced. Best avoided except for short stays.

D Little tucked away car park



Generally has spaces. Good place to put a campervan for the night. Also you can normally park on the approach road. Coming out of Neston, turn left at the mini roundabout before the Wirral Way railway bridge.

E Outside or behind the library



On the road outside library free and unrestricted after 6PM. The free and unrestricted parking behind the library is almost always very full.
